## \$100,000 Award to Improve Lives of Persons with Disabilities

The Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF) and SG Enable will be offering \$100,000 to five teams as jumpstart awards for new ideas to improve the lives of persons with disabilities. This Award is part of the inaugural "Enabling Community coLAB", to be launched by MSF and SG Enable on 5 April 2014.

The Enabling Community coLAB (Annex A) invites the community to learn, connect and come up with innovative solutions to some of the everyday challenges faced by persons living with disabilities. Through coLAB, participants will understand the challenges that persons with disabilities face in their daily lives. Through the ideas generated from the coLAB, the hope is to improve the lives of persons with disabilities and foster greater inclusion of them in society.

The event, to be held at \*SCAPE from 5-6 April 2014, is a two-day workshop for participants to develop their ideas with the help of facilitators and like-minded peers. At the finals in May 2014, up to five selected teams will be awarded up to \$20,000 each to turn their ideas into reality with the help of mentors and community partners (Annex B). DBS is the main corporate partner for the event.

Proposals that could eventually become social enterprises may be considered for funding under MSF's ComCare Enterprise Fund and Youth Social Entrepreneurship Programme for Start-ups (Annex C).

MSF and SG Enable would like to invite all interested parties to be a part of the Enabling Community coLAB and work towards the creation of impactful ideas to benefit the lives of persons with disabilities. Prior to the main workshop, participants will get to learn from relevant experts in the disability sector as well as hear first-hand the aspirations and challenges of inspiring individuals living with disabilities. Up to five “jumpstart awards” (a total of \$100,000 to be won) will be awarded. Winning teams will be further incubated by the coLAB’s partners.

### Available Funding Options

#### MSF's ComCare Enterprise Fund (CEF)

CEF aims to provide seed funding for sustainable new and existing social enterprises that train and employ the needy disadvantaged in Singapore to help them become self-reliant. CEF is open to all new and existing social enterprises within the social service sector. It does not fund social enterprises with objectives that fall in the arts, cultural, health or environmental sectors.

Approved social enterprises can get up to 80% of the total project cost (start-up and operating costs for up to two years), subject to a maximum of S\$300,000.

#### **Eligibility for CEF**

To be considered for CEF funding, the proposal must address 3 key areas:

- 1) A Compelling Social Objective(s)
- 2) A Viable Business Proposition
- 3) A Committed Team

#### Youth Social Entrepreneurship Programme (YSEP) for Start Ups

YSEP for Start Ups provides funding support to youths aged between 17 – 35 years in developing and implementing their social enterprise start-ups within the local social services sector. It does not fund applications within the arts, health or environment sectors. Start-ups can get up to 80% of the total projected capital expenditure and first year operating expenditure, capped at \$50,000.

Interested youths may apply to MSF through any of our administrating institutions of higher learning.

#### **Evaluation Criteria**

Applications will be evaluated in the following key areas:

- 1) Compelling social objective
- 2) Feasibility and sustainability
- 3) Quality of management team
