Shortlisted teams get to present their visualisations to a panel of judges at the IDA "Smart Nation Foundation: Data Works" conference on Oct 29. The top team will stand to win a cash prize of S\$6,000.

IDA Managing Director Jacqueline Poh said: "The Data Visualisation Challenge is a wonderful opportunity to bring together the Singapore Government's open data movement, where we've released more than 8,000 data sets to the public to use, to create applications, to create visualisations, hopefully to create businesses as well, and merge it together with SG50, to tell your Singapore story."

President of the Singapore Heritage Society, Dr Chua Ai Lin, is also excited to see what the participants come up with. "Because they're not from a history background, it'll be really interesting to see how they perceive historical data, the kind of questions they ask and the creative and fresh ways they might have to visualise it," said Dr Chua.
